Easy Start Hoodoo

Hoodoo (for me) is not an easy weave to start. The rings have such a tight ($^{\sim}$ 3) AR that you can easily get confused or misplace them. I start with a 2+2+1 like in the picture below. The first set of two I loosely wrap with a tie.



I then place a ring thru one side of the second 2 rings and the single ring on the end (marked with blue dot)



It should then look like the picture below.

Next place a ring on the other side where it is marked with a blue dot.



It should then look like the picture below.



Insert a ring thru the two you just added. Wahoo! You have a unit of Hoodoo and the start of the next unit ©
